



Fujitsu Dispute Collection Sheet



UNITE members at Fujitsu across the UK are striking over Jobs, Union Recognition, Pay and Pensions.

- Fujitsu proposes to rush through 1800 UK jobs cuts.
- Most staff don't have union recognition. Fujitsu also terminated our UK works council.
- Many over-60s have had their pensions *retrospectively* slashed by up to 15%, and Fujitsu has offered no compensation.
- Unite has demonstrated huge pay inequalities in Fujitsu, including a 16% gender pay gap and discrepancies on age and disability.
- Despite healthy profits, Fujitsu is refusing to become an accredited Living Wage employer and uses subcontractors and a subsidiary to undercut pay rates.
